COURSE 411

The State Championship race takes us to a new venue this year, Squilchuck State Park outside of Wenatchee. The course is just over 5 miles long with 680 feet of climbing per lap. The climbing is spread out over a long distance so most will consider it easier climbing compared to the Roslyn course. This course has considerable single track making for a fun ride. If you liked the flow trails at 360 Park with the banked turns, then you will really like this course. There are at least 25 banked and burmy turns on the course that are situated on rolling terrain.

The uphill start will surely spread riders out and while one mile gravity downhill will but a smile in your face, don't be surprised as you finish the downhill to the crowds cheering you on up to the finish. Most of the course is contained in heavy forest with minimal exposure. This could easily be the favorite course of the year.

PRE-RIDE

The course will be open for pre-ride to Saturday from 2:00PM to 5:00PM and on race day from 8:00AM to 9:30PM. We recommend that all riders pre-ride the course, ride with others and wear your race plate (this is who we identify riders in case of an emergency). Remember, pre-riding is only allowed during designated hours. Be sure to check with a League Official to ensure the course is ready for pre-riding. Any riders on the course before or after the designed pre-ride times may be penalized.

NEUTRAL SUPPORT

FSA Neutral support is brought to you by [Cycle Central](#) located in downtown Wenatchee.

Neutral support mechanics will be on hand to provide free mechanical assistance for any student-rider with a bicycle emergency. Student-riders are expected to come to each race with a fully functional, race ready bicycle.

From North Wenatchee: From Hwy 2, turn South in to Wenatchee on N Wenatchee Ave. Use the right 2 lanes to turn slightly right onto N Miller St. Then use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto N Chelan Ave. Follow the road as it turns into S Mission St and then Squilchuck Rd. Once on Squilchuck Rd it is about 7 miles to the state park. Watch for signs.

From East Wenatchee: From Hwy 28 head West over the George Stellar bridge across the Columbia River. Turn left at S Mission St which turns into Squilchuck Rd. Once on Squilchuck Rd it is about 7 miles to the state park. Watch for signs.

Staging position of each rider along with staging time will be published and available on race day.

STAGING AND WAVE INFORMATION

Staging order is based on series overall points; riders with the most overall points stage first. Riders without series points will be assigned a start position using a random number generator and staged after series overall points earners. A start list with row number for the rider to report to for staging will be published on race day.

ALL RIDERS MUST REPORT TO THE STAGING AREA 15 MINUTES BEFORE THEIR START TIME TO THEIR DESIGNATED ROW. If a rider is not present at their designated row when the staging assistant arrives to stage riders, then he/she forfeits their position and will have to go to the back of the line.

RACE PLATES

Each rider is issued a customized race plate for the season. THIS IS YOUR PLATE FOR THE ENTIRE SEASON, DO NOT LOSE IT. Replacement plates are \$10.00.

If you change race categories through the petition process, you will need to check in with registration to get your race plate modified.

Coaches, we encourage you to collect your rider's plates at the end of each race for safe keeping. Many plates are left on the bike and fly off when being transported on the vehicle.

COACHES MEETING

Coaches, this is where you'll get important information about race day, such as risk management, race conditions and anything else vital that we need to share with you. This includes important information that needs to be relayed and communicated with your student-riders. Sometimes we have to make changes due to weather and other circumstances so it's important at least one registered coach from your team attends this meeting. Roll will be taken.

OTHER IMPORTANT NOTES

- A Discover Pass is required for parking inside the state park.
- Keep dogs on leashes at all times.
- Please pack out what you pack in; no garbage receptacles will be provided.
- Everyone is expected to stay for the awards ceremony at the end of the day.

CAMPING

Tent camping will be available for Saturday night at Squilchuck State park by reservation. [Sign up here](#). Because of its location in relation to the village and course, once in you will not be able to leave until the course is torn down Sunday afternoon (~4pm).

RV camping will be available for both Friday and Saturday at the Mission Ridge ski resort parking lot, approximately 4.5 miles further up the road. Restrooms and trash receptacles will be available.
