Pre-Ride

We recommend that all riders pre-ride the course, ride with others and wear your race plate (this is how we identify riders in case of emergency.)

Saturday pre-ride will be from 2:00 PM - 5:00 PM, and on race day (Sunday) from 7:30 AM to 9:00 AM.

All girl riders are invited to a #girlboss group ride of the course on Saturday starting at 4:00 PM.

Only registered students and coaches may pre-ride.

Camping & Lodging

Primitive camping is \$12 per night per camping unit. All camping units must register using the self-registration process on site.

We are prohibited to use the electrical panel or water for RVs or personal use. Quiet hours are 10:00 p.m. – 6:30 a.m. Generator use is restricted to the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Do not put generators in areas of tall grasses or near fire ignition sources.

Adhere to fire ban restrictions. If permitted, fires are allowed in above ground fire pits ONLY. Prohibited from collecting firewood from State Parks land. Participants can bring their own wood supply.

Parking will be available at the village for all.
