## Neutral Support

Riverside Neutral Support is brought to you by Alex with Trek Redmond! Neutral support mechanics will be on hand to provide free mechanical assistance for any student-rider with a bicycle emergency. Student-riders are expected to come to each race with a fully functional, race ready bicycle.

## Camping

Check in on Friday will be open from 5pm - 10pm.

Check in on Saturday will be open from 11am - 6pm.

There will be a taped off, designated camping boundary we need all campers to stay within. We are not allowed to have any campers in the forested areas of the park.

This campground will have port-a-potties, and a potable water source. There are no showers or sinks.

## Don't Forget

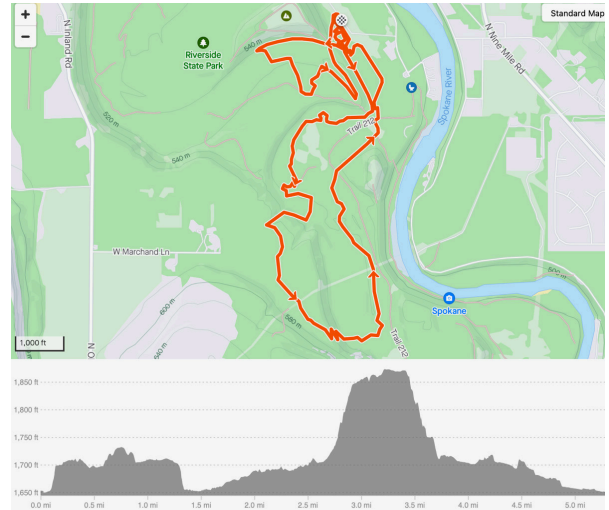
Dogs are allowed as long as **kept on a leash**

## The Course

One lap of the course is 5.8 miles, with ~600 feet of elevation gain. This year we will have an all new course layout then in previous years! The course will start with a short punchy climb then loop back into the start/finish area after the 1.5 miles for some fun features. Then the course will head back out for a decent climb and a challenging decent before heading back into the finish. Course will have a mix or traditional riverside rock gardens, short step ups/downs, tight tree singletrack, flat fast sections, optional A&B lines and plenty of areas to pass. Tip: might want to practice your log hops!
