## Who Participates?

All registered league riders can participate in the relay. This includes anyone who has raced in the open non-competitive previously, or has yet to race this season. Everyone must check in either Saturday afternoon or first thing Sunday. Riders will be assigned to teams once check in closes. Team assignments will be posted on the Results TVs shortly afterwards.

## Pre-Ride

Saturday from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm and on race day from 7:00 am to 8:30 am. Girl Boss Ride Saturday 3:00 pm at GB Flag.

## Neutral Support

Ride Roslyn will be on site on Saturday to provide Saturday mechanical help. Day of Neutral Support is provided by Alex with Trek Redmond. Neutral support mechanics will be on hand to provide free mechanical assistance for any student-rider with a bicycle emergency. Student-riders are expected to come to each race with a fully functional, race ready bicycle.

## Kitchen House

All teams and families are welcome to use the large kitchen house near the village for cooking/eating. First come first serve use.

## Camping

Check in on Friday will be open from 5pm - 10pm.  
Check in on Saturday will be open from 11 am - 6pm.  
Camping is located on site at Flying Horseshoe Ranch. Those who purchased cabin camping will check in with Penny. There will be port-a-potties on site, and a potable water tap. There are also two bath houses with showers, sinks and toilets for campers.

**550 feet elevation | 3.9 miles**

Starts with gravel road climb, rolling singletrack on a plateau, downhill singletrack back to start/finish. No technical features- this is a new trail and hopefully can be advanced over the coming years.

## Relay Guidelines

Check in with your "spring season" race plate on Saturday or by 9:00am on Sunday (we will have an orange WSCL tent dedicated to this process)

- Staging rows setup for teams to meet and strategize
- Coach assigned to each team
- 10am-2pm race - riders on course when horn goes off may finish lap - Clock starts at the gun / clock stops after 4 hours
- OLDEST (!) rider per team rides first – Le Mans start
- Everyone must ride one lap
- No consecutive laps or feed zones.
- Transition (bracelet swap) between timing mats
- Students must ride with their "spring season" race plate
- Hand-off a bracelet (no bracelet = no lap)
- All riders can receive outside mechanical assistance / bike swaps
