Pre-Ride

Saturday from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm and on race day from 7:00 am to 8:30 am. Girl Boss Ride Saturday 3:00 pm at GB Flag. We recommend that all riders pre-ride the course, ride with your race plate and ride with others!

Neutral Support

Race day Neutral Support is provided by Alex and Izzy with Trek Redmond. Neutral support mechanics will be on hand to provide free mechanical assistance for any student-rider with a bicycle emergency on Saturday. Student-riders are expected to come to each race with a fully functional, race ready bicycle.

Camping

Check in on Friday will be open from 5pm - 10pm.
Check in on Saturday will be open from 11 am - 6pm.
Camping is located on site at Gateway Park, 360 Trails. Camping at 360 Trails is open to both tent and vehicle camping. The RV/trailer spots are full due to there only being 8 spots. Vans/trucks are able to park on the grass lawn (race parking area) and camp there. Use the link to register or join the wait list, some do cancel.

No Stakes in the ground!

Same as in previous years, we are not allowed to stake any tents into the ground. This included team tents in the village. The blocks will be near the RV spots in the parking lot. Please put them back at the end of Sunday for easy pickup. 540 feet elevation | 5.3 miles

The course starts by leaving the village and gets to the trail via an open grass area good for passing. Once on trail, there is a single track climb, with short spurts of steep sections and some switchbacks. There are big rocks dispersed throughout. At the top, the trail is rolling, and then on Ticket to Ride, there are some a and b line options with small features. There is a last short climb on the road to pass on, then the final decent which is the most technical of the course, has some rock gardens and switchbacks until you're lead back to the village.
